The rabbis teach us: When governments mint a coin, they use one mold and all the coins come out the same. But when God made human beings, God too uses the same mold (Adam and Eve) and yet everyone is different. Therefore each of us should say, "For me the world was created." *Mishna Sanhedrin 4:5*
